Lesson Objectives: 1. to pronounce letters and words

2. to write letters and words

- 3. to encourage cooperation
- 4. to learn several English words

Assumptions: Students have learnt how to pronounce the letters earlier

Anticipated problems: Students can be uncertain of the pronouncing of letters in English.

Materials: -cards with letters -computer -lexica

Activity 1- How many words can you write? Aim: -make English words of a letter -talk English -listen to English -cooperate with the other students

 Procedure: The students work together in groups. The teacher says a letter. Then the students shall write English words that starts with this letter. Activity 2- Pick a letter and make a word Aim: -repeat English words -learn several English words		
 Procedure: 1. The students cooperating in groups get some cards. There is one letter on each card. 2. They pick five cards. The students make words by using as many of the letters they have picked as they can. For example: B, K, S, N, I BOOK- 2 points for using the letters B and K on the ca KING- 3 points for using the letters K, I and N on the The group that get most points in the end win. 	rds	Timing 15`
Activity 3- Use a computer and write words Aim: - learn to use the computer to write - learn to write several English words		
Procedure:1. The teacher says a letter and the students write words which starts with this letter on a computer.	Interaction t-s	Timing 5`
3. The teacher says different letters or the student pick a card with a letter. When the time is up the student counts how many words she/he has written.	S	10`

Next Lesson:

"Pick a letter and say a word" can also be done like this:

Students can do this without the teacher telling them which letters they can use. Students can do this in groups or individually.

The students can say one or several letters they shall use.

The students can pick one or several cards with letters they shall use.

Make different rules. For example: only the letters on the cards can be used or the students decide which letters they can use together with the letters on the cards. They can tell each other the words they have found, write the words on a paper or use the computer.

This lesson can be done like a competition and give points to a student or a group if they like.
