LESSON PLAN WATERWARMFIRE

Class: 7th grade Level: intermediate

No. of students: 28 Revision - Past simple and Present Perfect Simple

Lesson Objectives:

- 1. to consolidate and do further practice of the structure and use of Past Simple and Present Perfect Simple
- 2. to use ICT as a successful tool when teaching a foreign language
- 3. to encourage cooperation

Assumptions:

Students are already familiar with the structure of both tenses in Affirmative, Interrogative and Negative and with the basic uses. However, they still have problems distinguishing one tense from another. Also, students are able to work in groups, and they can handle basic computer skills.

Anticipated problems:

Students may find difficult to deal with working on the computer. Also, some students may be too competitive, thus unable to work in groups efficiently, having the tendency to stand out by trying to work individually rather than in a team.

Materials:

- Smart board
- computer
- markers
- notebooks
- WATERWARMFIRE software

Activity 1=Text 1

Aims:

- to consolidate and do further practice of the structure and use of Past Simple
- to use ICT as a successful tool when teaching a foreign language
- to encourage cooperation

Procedures: Interaction: Timing: Students sit 2 at one computer. S-S 25'

In pairs, students deal with text 1. S-T-S

When the puzzle has been solved and the text has been completed, the uses of the tenses are discussed.

Activity 1=Text 2

Aims:

- to consolidate and do further practice of the structure and use of Present **Perfect Simple**
- to use ICT as a successful tool when teaching a foreign language
- to encourage cooperation

Procedures: Interaction: Timing: 25' Students sit 2 at one computer. S-S S-T-S

In pairs, students deal with text 1.

When the puzzle has been solved and the text has been completed, the uses of the tenses are discussed.

Essential information:

In either the case of text 1 or text 2, what students have to do is complete the text. **Text 1** has missing **Past Simple verbal forms** whereas Text 2 has missing Past Participle verbal forms.

In order to complete either text, students first have to read the text ignoring the gaps and then go to the corresponding crossword puzzle to find there the required verbal forms. They will have to locate and discover the words, little by little, by moving the mouse and clicking on different words. The words can be placed in any direction in the puzzle, be it down, across, or diagonally. The buttons Text 1 and Text 2 lead the student to the crossword puzzle that he/ she has to solve.

Tips for students:

- Work in pairs on one computer.
- If you trigger the colour blue on the screen(WATER) you are not close to finding a whole word, if the colour is orange(WARM), then you are 2 letters away from the last one, and if it turns red(FIRE), you are one letter away from completing the whole word. Be patient! Keep trying!
- The moment you find a word, write it down.
- You have a hint button there; use it only if really necessary.

• Some verbal forms may be missing more than once in the text, but may appear only once in the word search crossword, whereas other verbal forms may appear twice in the crossword.

Tips for teachers:

- Your students should work in pairs.
- Write the tips for students on the board or show it on the smart board.
- Exemplify on the smart board how to find a word in the crossword puzzle.
- Ask your students to copy first the found verbal forms in their notebooks and then the whole text with the missing verbal forms as well. Also, ask students to read the whole text aloud while you are pointing out the verbal forms, and then give similar forms or elicit them form the children.
- As homework they may use the discovered verbal forms in their own texts.
- The texts and missing forms in each text are:
