

LESSON PLAN

Evaluation through game (an adaptation of the game *The country needs soldiers*)

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Date: November 4th, 2010 **Time of lesson:** from 8.30 to 9.20

Class: 6th grade Level: intermediate

No. of students: 30

Lesson Objectives:

- 1. to consolidate and do further practice of the structure and use of Present Simple and Present Continuous
- 2. to use ICT as a successful tool when evaluating (in the case of a foreign language)
- 3. to recognize and form well-structured sentences, especially in the Present Simple and Present Continuous
- 4. to encourage cooperation

Assumptions:

Students are already familiar with the structure of both tenses in Affirmative, Interrogative and Negative and with the basic uses. They are also aware of the structure and the proper order of words inside a correct sentence or question in English. Also, spelling simple words and the behaviour of common adjectives and of pronouns should be familiar to them.

Anticipated problems:

Students may find difficult to deal with working on the computer. Also, some students may be too competitive, becoming frustrated at times, especially if the partner manages to win more times than he/she does.

Materials:

- Smart board
- Computer
- The country need soldiers software



Activity 1- Checking homework

Aim:

- to consolidate and do further practice of the structure and use of Present Simple and Present Continuous

Procedures:

- 1. Students read their homework- a short composition on their daily routine and a short description of what is going on around them at the time of doing their homework.
- 2. The different uses and forms of both tenses are discussed in class. Students are encouraged to explain to each other why a certain tense is used and give a similar example.

Activity 2

Aims:

- to use ICT as a successful tool when evaluating (in the case of a foreign language)
- to recognize and form well-structured sentences, especially in the Present Simple and Present Continuous
- to encourage cooperation

Procedures:

First, the teacher demonstrates the game at the interactive board together with another student. Students will play the game in pairs, against each other, on the same computer. There is a time limit to click on the right answer of 15 seconds. Each time a student gives a right answer, his/her team gets another soldier. Each time a student gives a wrong answer, his/her team loses a soldier. Whoever gets all the soldiers (the blue team or the red team), wins the game; whoever loses all the soldiers, loses the game. The teacher monitors closely what each pair does at each computer, and how well and quickly they deal with the questions. Depending on how well they are able to recognize and form well-structured sentences, especially in the Present Simple and Present Continuous, they win or lose the game. The number of times they win or lose and the duration of a game on average will tell the teacher how well the students do. If they are both very good, one game will last a very long time.

Here are the questions and the answers:

There are 100 questions with 3 options each and the right answer for each. The exercises concentrate on Present Simple, Present Continuous and common sense grammar- basically on correct sentences.
