

# Game

## Horrid Henry's holiday - the text

Played two and two together!  
You need good legs and a computer.

- A. The teacher divides the students.  
In this game they have to be two and two, and have access to a computer.
- B. In advance the teacher has;
- selected a text (Horrid Henry's holiday)
  - copy the text as the same number of groups
  - cut the text into - for instance ten pieces or more, horizontal cuts, the text fragments should contain complete sentences
  - the teacher has hidden all the text fragments in different places, outside in the schoolyard
  - the teacher explains the game;
    1. one of the two students are going to run out find just one text piece
    2. go into the classroom again, find his / hers partner
    3. have access to a computer
    4. write the sentences from the text piece
    5. when they are ready, the other student runs out into the schoolyard and seek for another text piece (just one by one)
    6. in again, and write
    7. continue with this until they have found all the text pieces
    8. when the students have found all the specified numbers of text, they have to put the text together so there is a meaning and a story.
- C. Finally – read their story!
