

PULL THE ROPE

This can be played indoors or outdoors; however, it is more fun if played outside, maybe on a small stream (small river), or on sandy or even muddy ground. The children are divided into two teams and there is a border on the spot where the game is played: a line drawn in chalk/painted on the pavement, a net placed in the middle (if the game is played on a stream, on sandy or muddy ground) etc. The children are given a rope and one group is placed at one end of the rope while the other group is placed at the other end of the rope, both equally far away from the border; basically, the border stands in the middle of the rope. **Both groups start pulling the rope at the same time, trying to make their opponents cross the border; whoever crosses the border, loses the game, while the other group wins.** The game is more fun if the players fall in the sand, mud or even in the water, depending on the location.
