## WATER, WATER, FIRE, FIRE

One of the children is blindfolded and another child hides an object (generally a toy). The blindfolded child starts to look for the object. If the child is far away from the hidden object, the other kids will cry APA, APA! (WATER, WATER, WATER!). If the child starts approaching the object, the other children shout CALD, CALD, CALD !(WARM, WARM, WARM!). If the blindfolded child is very close to where the toy is hidden, the other kids shout FOC, FOC! (FIRE, FIRE, FIRE!) indicating thus the approximate location of the object. The game continues until the object is found; then another child is blindfolded and searches for the hidden object. The child who has found the object chooses the next child to be blindfolded. Instead of APA (WATER) and FOC (FIRE), children may shout RECE (IT'S COLD) and FRIGE (IT'S BURNING).
