Activity 1	Lead in - Discussion	Have you seen a castle? What is a castle? What was its function? How are places for building castles chosen? The teacher has prepared a slide show of pictures of famous castles, illustrating the differences in castle building in 5 different countries. The teacher first asks the students if they know the name of the castle and where it is located. The students describe the castle, if there are words they do not know, the teacher helps them. 	Interactive	The students work in pairs on computers and each group	
	activity	has to build a castle. Each group will see a text, related to castles. It will be better if the text is a story, so that it will be more interesting for the students. There are 20 blanks in the text, the verbs are missing. The students have to think of a suitable verb and put it in the correct tense. The tenses should be varied. When the students fill in the blank with a correct verb form, a part of the castle appears. After the whole text is filled in with the correct verb forms, the castle is built.  At the end of the activity the verb forms should be discussed – which verb should be chosen and why it is in the respective tense.
